#### Safe Routes to School

Reviewed concerns noted in June 2017. (Refer to hand-out from meeting.)

- Numbers 4, 5, 7, and 9 have been taken care of by city.
- Number 1: not enough students at the Charter School to warrant crosswalks, crossing guards, etc.
- Number 2: on a list of major long-term projects that addresses Kane Creed sewer, water, etc. 3-4 year plan
- Number 3: Has been restriped to include a bike lane. However, cars still move fast through this area.
- Number 6: on UDOT long-term list of new traffic lights; 2-3 years

#### Other

- Looking into a redesign of 400 North and 100 West that includes an intersection with better pedestrian walkways
- Advocating for a redesign of 400 East in the next year to include medians, parking, and stop signs. In the meantime there could be signage, a speed limit of 20 MPH; flashing light with speed limit, speed tables.
- No sidewalks on Millcreed/Holyoak.

#### Student Concerns

- Lights under bridges. Answer: It's a known issue. City is working on it.
- Questionable characters hanging out under bridge and surrounding area. Notify Chief Winder for law enforcement.
- Debris under bridge. Maintenance issue. City will send crew to clean up.
- Lifting concrete. Need specific locations; snap a picture and send it to David Everett.
