STUDENT TEST INFORMATION

Utah Performance Assessment System for Students (U-PASS) makes up the assessment and data foundation for reporting results of the state's accountability system, and includes six major assessment programs:

1. Core Assessment Criterion-Referenced Tests (CRTs) test reading / language arts, mathematics, and science.
 2. Direct Writing Assessment tests core curriculum standards for writing.
 3. Norm-Referenced Achievement Test (Iowa Test of Basic Skills - ITBS)
 4. Utah Basic Skills Competency Test given to 10th grade students who must pass the test in order to receive a diploma.
 5. Utah Alternate Assessment for special needs students.
 6. National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), mandated by state law, for grades 4 and 8 in selected Utah schools. Test results shown here are for Grand students. Evaluation & Assessment results from all schools available for view at www.usoe.k12.ut.us
- CORE ASSESSMENT CRITERION-REFERENCED TEST-The CRTs are given in the spring. Scores indicate the percentage of students at each grade level and subject who scored at proficient levels as specified by Utah's Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) Plan.
