Grand County School District Critical Incident Reunification Drill

Moab, UT. As part of ongoing efforts to improve Grand County School District (GCSD) safety procedures, GCSD will conduct an Off-Site Reunification Drill on Friday, May 17. The drill will be held with Grand County Middle School students, immediately following student release. Student and parent/guardian participation will be voluntary and signed consent forms will be required for student participation.

In preparation for the drill, GCSD will host a Parent/Guardian Reunification Information Session on Monday, May 6 at 6:30 p.m. at Grand County High School. The Information Session is open to all parents/guardians in the GCSD. Additional information on reunification planning can be found on the GCSD website under the "Safety" tab.

The drill is intended to provide students, parents/guardians and staff an opportunity to rehearse the process for returning students to families following a crisis incident. The reunification drill will also serve as a learning opportunity for GCSD to refine and improve the process. Other GCSD campuses will not be effected by the upcoming drill. As GCSD builds on the reunification process future drills will be held at all campuses.
