4 YEARS OF ENGLISH, MATH I, II, III AND AN ADVANCED MATH, EARTH SCIENCE, BIOLOGY, CHEMISTRY AND PHYSICS OR A COLLEGE LEVEL SCIENCE CLASS, WORLD GEOGRAPHY, WORLD HISTORY, US HISTORY, GOVERNMENT. 2 YEARS FOREIGN LANGUAGE CONSECUTIVELY.

FRESHMAN: SHOULD COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

ENG 9, MATH I, EARTH SCIENCE, WORLD GEOGRAPHY, HEALTH, DIGITAL BUSINESS COMM, SKILL AND TECH AND A .50 CREDIT IN PERFORMING ART (ELECTIVES FOR FRESHMAN ARE HARD TO FIND AS THEY HAVE NOT COMPLETED PREREQUISITES. FRESHMAN WANTING TO QUALIFY FOR REGENTS SCHOLARSHIP SHOULD TRY TO COMPLETE SPANISH 1 AND 2 DURING FRESHMAN AND SOPHOMORE YEARS)

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SOPHOMORES SHOULD COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:

ENG 10, MATH II, BIOLOGY, WORLD HISTORY, (SPANISH not required for graduation) , FIT FOR LIFE and any of the other Freshman courses they weren't able to complete. Sophomores have a few more electives to choose from but for the most part will have a full schedule completing required courses.

JUNIORS: THIS IS THE YEAR THAT WILL TYPICALLY SEPARATE THE STUDENTS WHO WILL GO TO TRADITIONAL COLLEGES VS. THOSE THAT WILL ENTER ANOTHER FORM OF POST HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION. STUDENTS GOING TO TRADITIONAL COLLEGES SHOULD FOLLOW THE REGENTS TRACK AS IT WAS DESIGNED TO PREPARE THEM FOR COLLEGE AND HELP THEM SCORE BETTER ON THE ACT. FOR STUDENTS THAT ARE ATTENDING TECHNICAL SCHOOLS OR OTHER POST HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION IT IS IMPORTANT THAT THEY FOLLOW THEIR CHOSEN "PATHWAYS" CTE PATHWAYS ARE IDENTIFIED DURING (CCR)- COLLEGE AND CAREER READINESS) MEETINGS WITH THE SCHOOL COUNSELOR. IT WILL BE HELPFUL IF TEACHERS ENCOURAGED STUDENTS TO STAY ON CHOSEN PATHWAYS OR TO GO SEE THE COUNSELOR IF THEY WANT TO CHANGE A PATHWAY. WE WOULD LIKE TO SEE THESE STUDENTS COMPLETE AT LEAST 2 PATHWAYS/TRADITIONAL COLLEGE STUDENT.

JUNIOR YEAR REQUIRED COURSES:

ENG 11, MATH III (MODERN MATH), CHEMISTRY OR OTHER 3RD YEAR SCIENCE, US HISTORY, FINANCIAL LIT. REMAINDER OF CLASSES SHOULD BE FILLED WITH PATHWAY CLASSES THEN ELECTIVES.

SENIOR YEAR REQUIRED COURSES:

ENG 12 (AP ENGLISH, ENG 1010, CREATIVE WRITING, JOURNALISM, BUSINESS COMMUNICATIONS) GOVERNMENT.

TRADITIONAL COLLEGE BOUND STUDENTS:

SHOULD BE TAKING AP COURSES AND/OR CONCURRENT ENROLLEMENT WITH USU.

OTHER POST HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATIONS STUDENTS:

SHOULD BE TAKING CLASSES REALTED TO THEIR CHOSEN PATHWAYS OR CTE RELATED CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT CLASSES.

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
