

RE: Utah Aspire+ end of year testing, Tuesday May 7<sup>th</sup>

Dear Parent/Guardian:

This is a reminder that on Tuesday, May 7<sup>th</sup>, your child will be taking the end of year assessment. The Utah Aspire+ assessment has replaced SAGE testing. This test is similar to the ACT in that it is timed and has four sections, math, science, reading, and English. The Aspire assessment is the pre-test for the ACT, so by taking this test, your child will become more familiar with the ACT format. When your child is a junior, they will take the ACT instead of the Aspire+ assessment.

Your child will complete all test sections in one day. They will not miss any class time as courses will not be taught on the testing day. It is important for your child to be here on the 7<sup>th</sup>. There will be a make-up day on the 9<sup>th</sup>, but during that day, your child will miss their classes to take the test. The testing schedule for the 7<sup>th</sup> of May is on the reverse side of this page.
